Describe Paul's life before he encountered Christ. (Acts 26:4-11) Describe Paul's conversion to Christ. (Acts 26:12-20) Describe Paul's life after he made Jesus his Lord. (Acts 26:21-23)

You Before Christ

Read Romans 3:23. Who sins?

Read Romans 3:12. Who is righteous?

Read Romans 5:12. What is the result of sin?

How would you describe your life if you didn't have Christ? How did you know you were separated from God?

Encountering Christ

Read Romans 5:8. What did God do?

Read Romans 10:9-10. What does someone need to do to be saved from sin?

Read Romans 10:13. Who can be saved?

Read John 14:6. Why is Jesus so special?

How did you come to put your faith in Jesus? How did you know that Jesus was the only way to make things right with God?

With Christ

Read 1 Corinthians 5:20-21. Who are we with Christ? What does that mean? How does verse 21 describe us with Christ? Read John 1:12-13. What do we get when we believe in Jesus? Read Romans 5:1-2. How are we made right with God?

Take some time over the next few weeks to consider these passages and your story. Write out your story, so you can share it with a loved one. Your personal faith story should include what your life was like before Christ, how you encountered Christ, and who you are now with Christ.
