Read Jonah 3:1-2. What do you notice is happening here? How is this similar to Jonah 1:1-2? How is it different? Does God want the same thing?

Read Jonah 1:3 & 3:3-5. Compare Jonah's responses. Why did Jonah barely obey? Is barely obedient, still obedience? Why or why not?

Read Jonah 3:6-10. Why do you think the king of Nineveh responded the way he did? Compare the people of Nineveh's obedience to the king to Jonah's obedience to God.

What does repentance look like? Why is repentance a proper responce to God's judgement?

How does God respond to obedience in both cases of Jonah and the people of Nineveh? What does this tell us about God? How does this encourage us to be obedient to God?

Personal Reflection

Have you been barely obedient to God? Do you think being barely obedient is the best way to respond to God's desire for your life? How can you fully surrender to God this week?
